ENDING SERVICE: To use single-point

Navigation (Navigation that does not involve stops from a route service provider), you must be out of service – that is, not running a specified route. If you've just logged in (and haven't selected a route), skip down to p. 2.

ENDING SERVICE FROM THE STOPS LIST:

1.) Tap Switch Run at the top right. The Switch Run screen will appear.



2.) Tap End Service at the bottom right.

A confirmation dialog box will appear.

3.) Tap Yes.



4.) Continue with the steps on p. 2.

ENDING SERVICE FROM NAVIGATION:

1.) Tap the Menu button.

The Navigation Menu dialog box will appear.




2.) Tap Switch Run.

The Switch Run screen will appear, as shown in the preceding section.


- **3.)** Tap End Service at the bottom right.
- **4.)** Tap Yes in the confirmation dialog box.
- **5.)** Continue with the steps on p. 2.

AFTER LOGGING IN: After you've logged in, MAKE SURE TO NOT SPECIFY A ROUTE. If a route is associated with your MDT, you will be asked if you want to run that route.




1.) Tap No.

2.) Tap OK.


If NO route is associated with your MDT (or if you just tapped No in step 1), you will be asked if you are running a route.

1.) On the Home screen, tap Navigation.




4.) Tap Enter Address.




14.) Tap Yes.

Navigation will plot directions to the location and display them on the map.




15.) Proceed to the location, following the given directions.


If your school district has chosen to dim the map while you are driving, only the directions will appear on the left.



As you approach the address, a flag will appear on the map, showing the location.




When you reach the address you entered, the stop will be marked as arrived with diagonal lines.

USING RECENT PLACES: 1.) On the Navigate screen, tap Recent Places.

2.) Tap the address to which you'd like to be directed again.

USING FAVORITES: 1.) On the Navigate screen, tap Favorites.

2.) Tap the favorite location to which you'd like to be directed again.



3.) If you'd like to name the favorite with words instead of numbers, tap the ABC key.




4.) Type the name you'd like for the favorite. You can use numbers as well by tapping the 123 key.
